AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court praying for protection of life and liberty from respondents 4, 5 and 6, from whom they apprehend danger. It is asserted that these persons arrayed as respondents 4 to 6 are interfering in the liberty and life of the petitioners and there is every likelihood of they harassing the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners are major and, therefore, apprehend danger at the hands of the said respondents. Highlighting this aspect, petitioners have submitted a representation/complaint dated 21.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., Police Station Julka, Tehsil and District Patiala-respondent No.3 respectively.

He contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the representation/complaint dated 21.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 and

S.H.O., Police Station Julka, Tehsil and District Patiala-respondent No.3, to look into the representation/complaint dated 21.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and if some substance is found therein, take appropriate steps in accordance with law ensuring that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardised at the hand of respondents 4 to 6.
