After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition to pursue the pending application for restitution filed in Civil Suit No.542 of 2016 titled as ***Amar Pal Singh and another vs Ravjot Singh and others*** pending in the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana and the next date of hearing is 11.07.2019. He also submits that an attempt to overreach the orders passed by this Court as well as the Hon'ble Apex Court has been made and the trial Court may be asked to opine thereupon as well.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court is directed to decide the application for restitution within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. The trial Court shall also opine as to whether there has been any violation of any order of injunction passed by the Civil Court/this Court/Hon'ble the Apex Court or any other order passed by the said authorities.

In case, the petitioners are still aggrieved by the order passed, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
