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KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE: (Oral)

After the matter was heard at some length, when confronted with the observation that in view of the Government Circular No. 22/2/2012-3FP/2/83 dated 30.04.2015 it was open to the respondent-department not only to take action under rule 8 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970, for any misconduct committed during the extension of service period but the extension was also liable to be withdrawn without issuing any notice and, thus, there was no illegality in the impugned action of the respondents, learned counsel for the appellant, finding it difficult to assail the proposition, sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of the appeal.

Prayer made is allowed.

Appeal accordingly stands dismissed as withdrawn.
