Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 38, dated 11.04.2017 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Division No.6, District Jalandhar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 29.11.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 18.12.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No. 17, dated 17.01.2019 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide letter No. 179 G/JRK dated 18.01.2019.

Petitioner has deposited the amount of Rs.15,000/- in the relevant heads as directed by this Court vide order dated 28.01.2019. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, is satisfied that compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, dated 17.01.2019 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No. 38 dated 11.04.2017 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioners only.

Disposed of accordingly.
