ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.22, dated 18.04.2019, under Sections 379, 324, 323, 326, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature. They are also alleged to have taken away a sum of Rs.41-42000/- from the pocket of the complainant. She also contends that the FIR was registered on the basis of a misunderstanding. The matter has now been compromised and a petition for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed in Court.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 27.05.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 27.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
