GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 2 to protect their lives and liberty which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondent No.5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that younger son of petitioner No.1 plies auto-rickshaw and parks the same outside his house but the same was objected to by respondent No.5-Mukesh Kumar, who resides opposite to their house in the same lane. It has been submitted that respondent No.5 happens to be employed in Police Department and had caused injuries to petitioner No.2-Rakesh Kumar and that although the said Rakesh Kumar was medico legally examined at Civil Hospital, Jalandhar but no FIR

was lodged. It has further been submitted that respondent No.5 being in Police Department is now pressurizing the petitioners to compromise the matter.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously in accordance with law.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
