Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.129, dated 26.10.2017, registered under Sections 302/34 IPC, at Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prosecution has examined 4 witnesses, namely, Jang Bhadur, Des Raj, Ashok Bawa and Amit Sharma and none of them have supported the case of the prosecution and rather they have been got declared hostile. This position is not disputed by learned counsel for the State. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 29.10.2017 and is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 29.10.2017, is not involved in any other case and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
