This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 10.10.2018 passed in CRM-M-44719 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the matter and to dispose of representation dated 10.8.2018 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously."

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order Annexure R-1 no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy against the said order.
