This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.50 dated 30.03.2019 registered on 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District

As per the allegations, the police party was on regular patrol duty and when they were passing outside the house of the father of the petitioner they saw that the petitioner, his father and his mother were unloading some boxes from the motorcycle and secreting them in the ground. On seeing the police they escaped but the police recovered 12 boxes (containing 6000 tramadol tablets).

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was not arrested at the spot and his antecedents are absolutely clean.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jagtar Singh

POOJA SHARMA has accepted these factual assertions.
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In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 10.06.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
