Present revision petition under Section 401 of the Criminal Procedure Code is directed against the judgment 04.03.2013 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge (Fast Track Court), Patiala, whereby the appeal, filed by respondents No.2 and 3-accused against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 17.03.2010 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, was allowed. The judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 17.03.2010 were set aside and respondents No.2 and 3-accused were acquitted.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner (who was appointed as Legal Aid Counsel by this Court) contended that after filing of the petition, the petitioner never came forward to this Court for assisting the Court and, as such, his appointment as Legal Aid Counsel in this case was

made. He has made strenuous efforts to find out the correct address of respondents No.2 and 3, but could not find out the same, so the service upon respondents No.2 and 3 could not be effected.

Otherwise also, both the Courts below have already appreciated the entire facts and evidence and there is no other ground for interference in the findings given by the Courts below. Moreso, there is a huge delay of 565 days in filing the present revision petition which has remained unexplained. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
