This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail pending trial in FIR No. 97 dated 31.08.2017, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act,1985, registered at Police Station Khamano, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

It has gone uncontroverted that the alleged recovery from the petitioner was of two litres of intoxicating liquid and as per chemical examiner's report the contents were found to be containing Oxytocin and Morphine Sulphate.

In the light of such heavy/commercial quantity allegedly recovered from the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to extend in his favour the concession of bail.

At this stage counsel would make a prayer that he would confine the scope of the instant petition for issuance of directions to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, informs the Court that out of eight prosecution witnesses cited two have already been examined and the remaining are all official witnesses.

In view of the above and while declining the concession of bail to the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite and conclude the trial within a period of four months from today.
