The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 8.3.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 6244 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the representation (Annexure P-4) keeping in view availability of posts in Hisar and the fact that persons lower in merit to the petitioner have been posted in Hisar and this exercise be completed within a period of two months.”

Short reply dated 4.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Maheshwar Sharma, Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula filed in Court is taken on record. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Along with the reply, order dated 25.6.2019 has been annexed,

whereby the representation of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 25.6.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
