Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.35 dated 28.02.2019 under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 201, 411, 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar.

Power of Attorney filed on behalf of the complainant is taken on record.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contended that the matter has otherwise been settled between the parties and separate petition has been filed for quashing of F.I.R. in question. Co-accused Sukhwinder Singh and Udhav Kapoor have already been admitted to bail by this Court

vide order dated 13.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-20580-2019. The petitioners are in custody since 28.02.2019 and trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners behind the bars, so they be released on bail.

Learned counsel representing the complainant has affirmed the factum of compromise.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The present petitioners, namely, Sidarth and Rahul Ahuja, who are in custody since 28.02.2019 are ordered to be admitted to regular bail on their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
