Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer investigation of FIR No.241 dated 03.09.2018 under Sections 324, 323, 34, 120-B IPC and Sections 498-A and 406 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda to Bureau of Investigation, Punjab or some district other than District Bathinda.

Prayer has also been made for issuance of necessary direction to the police to conduct a fair and speedy investigation in FIR No.221 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 379 IPC (added later on) at Police Station City Faridkot, which was got registered by the petitioner for the same incident.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4

Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to expedite the investigation in the
aforementioned two FIRs.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy
Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents
No.1 to 4.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned
State counsel during the course of the day.

September, 2018, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to
respondent No.4 Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to expedite
investigation.
