The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0199 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 419, 170, 182 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Ferozepur.

On 03.12.2018 the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of 7 months in lodging of the FIR.

Learned State counsel seeks time to verify the same.

Adjourned to 23.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all

the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 03.12.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Sharma Singh, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the order dated 03.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
