The writ petition filed by the petitioner for direction to respondent to expedite the proceedings in the complaint initiated by the petitioner was disposed of on 21.12.2018. Directions were issued to Deputy Commissioner, Patiala to treat the writ petition as representation and decide the same within six weeks on receipt of copy of the judgement. It was further ordered that in case the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the claim of the petitioner is not admissible, in that case a speaking order be passed in the matter.

Today learned State counsel has produced order dated 24.7.2019, copy of the same is taken on record and supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the claim made by the petitioner has been looked into and there were encroachments in Khasra No. 133 which were removed and possession handed over to Gram Panchayat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case some grievance still survives after passing of the order.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
