Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 3 to 5 regarding the proceedings pending before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh arising out of a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

As per the office report, notices issued to respondent No.3 have been received back with the report that no such Company exists on the same address and respondent No.4 is stated to have gone to Kuwait and respondent No.5 is not residing at the given address.

Learned counsel appearing for U.T. Chandigarh has stated that in pursuance to the P.O. proceedings initiated against

the private respondents, the trial Court has already declared them proclaimed offenders vide order dated 10.01.2018 and the police is taking all efforts for their arrest, as and when they are arrested, they will produce before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition at this stage with liberty to approach the trial Court for redressal of the grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
