This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioners Inder Kumar, Pritam Singh and Karam Singh in case bearing FIR No.86 dated 15.11.2018 registered at Police Station Sanour, District Patiala under Sections 323, 354, 506, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 30.11.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjan Singh, Police Station Sanour, District Patiala who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 30.11.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
