The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.93 dated 15.2.2019 under Sections 379-A/34 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he had snatched a bag containing money from the complainant at the time of marriage of the complainant's niece. He also contends that a knife is alleged to have been recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is 23 years of age and is not involved in any other case. The petitioner is in custody since 15.2.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from H.C. Rajesh Deep, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented but no witness has been examined so far.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 23 years of age, he is not

involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant him regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
