Despite service, none has put in appearance on behalf of
respondent No.2.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code
of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for quashing of FIR No. 34 dated
30.07.2018, under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860
(for short 'IPC') and section 411 IPC was added later on, registered at Police
Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar as well as the subsequent
proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Manvir Kaur, S.I.,
has apprised this Court that after investigation in the matter, report under
Section 173 Cr.P.C. was submitted on 31.08.2018 and after framing of the
charges on 12.09.2018, out of total six prosecution witnesses, three have
already been examined. Further apprised that now the case is fixed for
09.04.2019 for recording the testimony of remaining prosecution witnesses.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to quash the FIR in question at this stage.

Dismissed.

However, the observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and petitioner would be at liberty to raise all his pleas before learned trial court as per law.
