This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 98 dated 11.6.2016 registered under Sections 324/323/148/149 IPC, 1860 (Section 326, 34 IPC added later on) at PS Baghapurana, District Moga.

Learned counsel has argued that petitioner was granted concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 28.11.2016 in CRM-M-40061-2016 but the petitioner could not appear.

After arguing for some time and observing that this Court is not inclined to give any relief to the petitioner learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition. He stated that he would surrender before the Court and move an application for regular bail and pray that the same be decided expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the observation that the petitioner would surrender on or before 4.6.2019 and move an application for regular bail and the same be decided on merits expeditiously but in any case on or before 6.6.2019.

Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed as withdrawn.
