The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.106 dated 20.09.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506 & 34 IPC and Sections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(r) & 3(1)(s) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Kot Bhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on the basis of compromise dated 26.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) along with all consequential proceedings.

In compliance to the order dated 30.11.2018, passed by this Court, report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gidderbaha, has been received by reporting that statement of the complainant as well as accused has been recorded and both the parties have entered into compromise which is without any coercion or undue influence and is genuine.

The offences are under Section 323, 341, 506 IPC read with

Section 34 IPC and various provisions of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act. Since the parties have compromised the matter, the trial of the case will be useless exercise and it is unlikely to succeed. As such, FIR No.106 dated 20.09.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506 & 34 IPC and Sections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(r) & 3(1)(s) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Kot Bhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, along with all consequential proceedings, stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
