This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 10.1.2019 passed in CWP No. 347 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

" Without going into the merits of the case and without commenting upon the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations (Annexures P-1 to P-3) of the petitioners by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly."

Reply by way of affidavit of Ms. Astha Modi, IPS Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, has been filed today annexing Annexures R1 to R3, same is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for petitioner. The claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

In view of above learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
