This is an application for placing on record the copy of RTI application dated 30.04.2015 and replies dated 04.06.2015/08.06.2015.

The application is allowed and aforementioned documents are taken on record as Annexures P-14 and P-15(Colly), subject to all just exceptions.

CWP No. 11506 of 2012

In the present writ petition, the grievance which has been raised by the petitioner is that he is entitled for interest on the delayed release of the payment @ 18% per annum.

In the reply filed by the respondents, an order dated 04.01.2018 has been attached, wherein, it has been mentioned that all the amount for

which the petitioner has been found entitled for, has been released alongwith interest and total amount of ₹1,72,754/- has been paid to the petitioner.

Further, in respect of the averment which has been made by the petitioner in para 12 that the petitioner has not been paid pension after November, 2011, the respondents have clarified in the reply that the petitioner is being paid pension regularly and even the arrears of revised pension amounting to ₹17,703/- from 01.04.2008 till 30.11.2012 have also been released to the petitioner and have been deposited in his account.

In view of the above, the claim which has been made by the petitioner in the present writ petition stands satisfied.

The present writ petition is being disposed of as infructuous. However, as there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, he is given liberty to file appropriate representation in case, any amount for which the petitioner thinks, he is entitled for and has not been released by the respondents, by filing appropriate representation with the respondents within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 shall pass appropriate order on the said representation within a period of three months thereafter.
