This second petition has been filed by petitioner-Sukhwinder Singh Ahluwalia under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.100 dated 10.08.2016 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Admittedly, earlier the petitioner filed Criminal Misc. No. M-13831 of 2017, which was dismissed vide order dated 25.04.2017.

No new ground or changed circumstances are there.

Accordingly, this petition being without having any merit is dismissed.

However, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, he surrenders before the trial Court within the stipulated period and moves application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to consider the same and pass necessary orders in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.
