GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.120 dated 17.07.2018 under Sections 306/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station city Phagwara, District Kapurthala.
2. The FIR was registered at the instance of Kuldeep Chand wherein it has been alleged that his son Jatinder Megra was married to Renu in the year 2012 and that his son started residing in Street No.13 Prempura, Mohalla Phagwara along with his wife. It is alleged that on 16.07.2018 the complainant was informed telephonically by Budh Ram that

complainant's son Jatinder Megra had died due to electric shock. It is alleged that since Jatinder Megra's wife Renu did not inform about the death of complainant's son and the dead body of complainant's son had been kept in mortuary, the complainant suspects that his son has been murdered by giving electric shocks to him or was forced to end his life.

3. On the last date of hearing, it had been submitted on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner that in fact the petitioner is in family way and was expecting. This Court had directed the Superintendent, Central Jail to ensure that the petitioner is given adequate medical treatment. Report of Medical Officer, Central Jail, Kapurthala has been received to the effect that the petitioner is pregnant and her expected date of delivery is 4.4.2019.
4. In view of the aforesaid position, wherein the petitioner is stated to be in advance stage of pregnancy, the petition is allowed on medical grounds and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
5. This petition stands accepted accordingly.
