INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.78 dated 15.03.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabhgarh, District Faridabad, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148, 149, 452, 506 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with fire-arm weapon and has fired from the same. The main injury on the head of Manish has been

attributed to the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that no witness has been recorded so far and the case is at preliminary stage.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that there is every chance of tampering with the evidence, if the petitioner being the main accused, is released on regular bail, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
