Petitioner-company has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution for directing the respondents to issue Form-C as prescribed under Section 8 of the Central Sales Tax Act 1956 read with Central Sales Tax (R&T) for purchase of Diesel from oil marketing companies for generation/distribution of power for transactions conducted after 30.09.2018. Reliance had been placed upon judgment of a Division Bench of this Court rendered in CWP No.8563 of 2018 decided on 30.05.2018 titled M/s DLF Power and Services Ltd. Vs. State of Haryana & Ors.

reply and the matter was listed on 13.06.2019. On 13.06.2019 learned State Counsel on instructions submitted that the writ petition had become infructuous as prayer of the petitioner has been considered. Upon this counsel for the petitioner had sought time to verify the same.
