GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.204 dated 30.08.2018 under Sections 365, 342, 384, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Dehlon, District Luchiana and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Mr. Haranpreet Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on

record.

3. Vide order dated 01.12.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioner as well as of complainant-Tavish Rai have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence from any quarter.
5. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.204 dated 30.08.2018 under Sections 365, 342, 384, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Dehlon, District Luchiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
