Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.82 dated 02.02.2019 under Sections 379-B, 365, 34, IPC, Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that while making initial complaint which was the basis of FIR, the complainant-victim had stated that 4 young people/boys were involved in the incident and he is unable to recognize their faces. However, after 5 days, he makes a supplementary statement and states that 3 boys were involved and identifies the three boys including the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 08.02.2019. The investigation is complete and the challan has been presented. The case has been remitted to Sessions Judge.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has submitted that the complainant-victim was nervous and due to which he made the initial statement. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
