Petitioner- Amarjeet is aggrieved by the impugned judgment dated 21.02.2015, passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala whereby, respondents No.1 to 5, were ordered to be released on probation of good conduct for a period of one year on their furnishing personal bond/probation bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount each as per Section 4 of Probation of Offender Act, 1958 with the condition that they would maintain a peace and be of good behaviour during the aforesaid period of one year. Further they were directed to pay compensation amounting to Rs.10,000/- to each injured/complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for enhancement of the compensation.

Perusal of the order dated 02.01.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala shows that compensation amount was adequately enhanced to Rs.20,000/- from Rs.10,000/-. Further there is no prayer for award of sentence of imprisonment before the appellate Court.

Therefore, no ground is made out for award of sentence of imprisonment.

Consequently petition is dismissed.
