The petitioner(s) prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0207 dated 01.11.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has submitted that the parties have settled their dispute by way of settlement, in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. He further submits that petitioner(s) have handed over a demand draft of ₹3,00,000/- along with 3 cheques of ₹ 5,00,000/- lakhs each payable on 20.06.2019, 20.08.2019 and 20.10.2019 to the respondent(s)/complainant(s). Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) on instructions from the petitioner No.2 who is present in the Court submits that the cheques will be duly honoured on the given dates.

The affirmation made by the petitioner No.2 is accepted by the learned counsel for the respondent(s)/complainant(s), however he submits that liberty be granted to the respondent(s)/complainant(s) to revive this petition if any of the cheque is dis-honoured on the given dates.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner(s) vide order dated 03.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and with a further condition that the 3 cheques issued by the petitioner(s) be honoured on the give dates, in terms of the settlement, failing which it will be open for the respondent(s)/complainant(s) to apply for recalling of the order.
