AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioner filed a writ petition for direction to the Central Board of Secondary Education (for short 'CBSE') to carry out a correction of date of birth in the matriculation certificate. The writ Court declined to intervene for issuance of direction to the CBSE, however, direction issued to the respondent-Amity International School, Gurugram to examine the request dated 28.11.2018 and to take final decision.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the matter has been considered and it has been found that correction cannot be done. However, he states that a reasoned order would be communicated to the petitioner within 15 days from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that liberty be granted to the petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law against the order passed.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

The petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition, in case, the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent today in Court is not adhered to.
