In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that vide order dated 31.10.2018 (Annexure P-8), petitioner was granted benefit of three years qualifying service for superannuation pension and DCRG (Gratuity) but the said order is not being implemented by the respondents and the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled under the said order, are not being released to the petitioner without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made representation dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-9) to the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any

opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-9) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
