RAMENDRA JAIN, J.

Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No. 65 dated 21.6.2005, under Sections 452, 323, 336 and 34 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

In nutshell, the petitioner was booked in the aforesaid FIR in the year 2005 and was released on bail after his arrest. However, in the year 2008, the petitioner absented and went abroad. Consequently, he was declared proclaimed offender on 1.9.2009. Finally, he surrendered before the Court on 21.7.2018 and since then he is in custody.

Learned counsel contends that a compromise has been arrived at between the complainant party and the petitioner. A good lesson has been learnt by the petitioner for his jumping bail. Therefore, considering the custody period of the petitioner, he may be granted regular bail.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, the petition is

allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
