Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 24.04.2019, with only 10 kgs of poppy husk stated to have been recovered from him, with no other criminal case registered against him.

Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, submits that though the quantity stated to have been recovered is not disputed, there is yet another case registered against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the quantity of poppy husk alleged to have been recovered from the petitioner is 10 kgs of poppy husk, with the commercial quantity being above 50 kgs, the petition is allowed. He shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
