Delay of 48 days in filing the appeal is condoned for the reasons mentioned in Civil Misc. No.2543-LPA-2019 and the same stands disposed of.

This intra-court appeal filed under Clause X of the Letters Patent is directed against the judgment and order dated 06.03.2019 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition filed by the appellant herein. The appellant is seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the select list issued by respondent No. 3, containing the names of the candidates selected by the respondent for issuance of the appointment letters for the posts of Music Teacher.

Undisputed facts are that in pursuance of an advertisement issued in the newspaper inviting applications for the post of Music Teacher, the appellant-petitioner was one of the applicants. A recruitment mela was

held at Kisan Bhawan from 17.09.2016 to 19.09.2016. Petitioner participated in the same and was interviewed. 21.09.2016 was the date fixed for checking of the educational qualifications. On the said date, though the appellant-petitioner appeared but he failed to produce the requisite certificate to show that he was having a diploma as required. Subsequently, after the process was over when he procured the certificate, he sent it to the department by a registered post. When no response was received, after about two years he approached this Court by filing a writ petition.

In the facts and circumstances, since on the day when the appellant was required to produce the diploma certificate, he failed to do so, we find no illegality in the judgment of the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition. The appeal is devoid of merit and accordingly stands dismissed.
