Heard learned counsel for the two sides and perused the records. A stand has been taken by the respondent side that the petitioner Balbir Kaur @ Balvir Kaur happens to be estranged daughter-in-law of Khushi Ram respondent No.4 and consequent upon receipt of complaint of the petitioner against private respondents, the police have investigated into the allegations and found out in the inquiry that Khushi Ram has bequeathed his share of the property in favour of his heirs and that the petitioner being daughter-in-law of Khushi Ram has levelled false allegations and there is only simplicitor dispute over land which the parties claim to be an ancestral one.

In the light of the same, no further action is necessitated by this Court on the petition and the same stands disposed off. However, the petitioner is at liberty to invoke appropriate legal remedy, if so advised.
