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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

It is the case projected on behalf of the petitioner that he is being unnecessarily harassed by official respondents No.3 and 4 and who are acting at the behest of private respondent No.5 in relation to a complaint having been made. Counsel submits that the dispute, if any, between the petitioner and respondent No.5 would be of a civil nature. It is averred that respondent Nos.3 and 4 are calling the petitioner repeatedly to the police station and are forcing him to enter into a settlement and to pay money to respondent No.5.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa to look into the matter against the backdrop of a representation dated 17.04.2019 at Annexure P-2 i.e. stated to have already been submitted and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
