After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his arguments to the extent that since the petitioner is in custody for the last about one year and six months and the case is still at stage of staring prosecution evidence, a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Devinder, has submitted that FSL report was submitted on 22.01.2018 and the charges have not yet been framed in this case. It is further submitted that there are total nine prosecution witnesses and they will appear before the trial Court as and when required.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
