The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 217 dated 06.10.2013, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149, 323 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City and later on offence under Section 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 was deleted vide DDR No. 47 dated 17.02.2014, on the basis of compromise dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 08.01.2019, report dated 14.01.2019 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 217 dated 06.10.2013, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149, 323 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (offence under Section 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of

Cantonment, District Amritsar City, and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
