1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 270 dated 8.10.2018 under Sections 395/34 IPC, Police Station IT Park, Chandigarh and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 25.1.2019 the parties have been directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for the purpose of getting their statements recorded qua factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh has been received to the effect that the police has presented challan against

five accused namely Rahul Singh, Amit Kumar, Gautam, Mohit Mishra and Kuldeep Singh and all the said accused stand acquitted as the complainant did not support the case. It has further been stated therein that no challan was ever filed against the petitioner and no case is pending against him.

4. In view of the aforestated report, it is apparent that there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today. The petition, as such is dismissed.
