The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 186 dated 21.12.2013, under Sections 447, 323, 427, 506, 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No. 6, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with others tried to take forcible possession of the land and stopped the construction being carried out by the complainant Company. He, however, contends that the petitioner had sold the land to the complainant but the complainant had also taken possession of two marlas, which was not sold by him to the complainant. He also contends that the proceedings in FIR No. 186 dated 21.12.2013 had been stayed by the Supreme Court by order dated 23.04.2018. He further contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted anticipatory bail but he could not appear before the trial Court on one date because he had noted a wrong date and, therefore, his bail was cancelled. He undertakes that henceforth the petitioner

shall appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 28.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 01.07.2019 and has been granted interim bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court, the order dated 28.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
