The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.2 to 5 to protect her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.6 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.6 is posted as Sub-Inspector, 9 Batalion Mall Mandi, Amritsar. The petitioner has made representation dated 17.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.4 Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural and further representation dated 07.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.3 Inspector General of Police Border Range, Amritsar, but no action has been taken against respondent No.6.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4-Senior

Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural to consider the aforesaid representations (Annexures P-1 and P-2) made by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of respondents No.6 to 8, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (rural) to look into the contents of representations (Annexure P-1 and P-2) and to act strictly in accordance with law.
