Concededly the petitioner undertook the examination, conducted for the post of Tradesman, way back in the year 2011 and has chosen to file the writ petition in the year 2019.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was wrongly advised to pursue his appointment on compassionate ground in view of the demise of his brother, who died in harness, and therefore did not take appropriate steps earlier.

3. The petition is hopelessly time barred.

4. In view of the above, the petition is dismissed. However, the respondents are at liberty to take a lenient view on the representation dated 06.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) and for the reasons stated therein, pass appropriate orders.
