Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the counsel for the Municipal Council, Jind, it is apparent that the information, which has been sought by the petitioner, pertains to the same complaint dated 17.07.2017 which had been filed by him earlier.

In the said complaint, this Court, after passing of the orders by the State Information Commission, the petitioner approaching the Court, passed various orders. In pursuance thereto, fresh demarcation was carried out in the light of the stand taken by the respondents that the said application was not traceable and no action, therefore, was taken on the said complaint. Demarcation report was submitted to this Court and in the light of the status report-cum-affidavit, which was filed in this Court as also the

demarcation report, this Court was pleased to dispose of the said writ petition i.e. CWP No. 1605 of 2019 titled as Kuldeep Vs. State of Haryana and others on 14.05.2019.

In the light of the orders passed in CWP No. 1605 of 2019 titled as Kuldeep Vs. State of Haryana and others on 14.05.2019, the cause of action does not survive in the present complaint, which has been submitted by the petitioner as the information stands supplied to the petitioner in the earlier writ petition preferred by him.

The writ petition, therefore, stands disposed of accordingly.
