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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.72 dated 27.7.2017 under Sections 325, 323, 427, 452, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Mr. D.K. Sihag, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents No.2 & 3 and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

3. Vide order dated 4.12.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Abohar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Badal Parkash & injured-eye witness Krishna Devi have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant & injured-eye witnesses have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily, without any threat or coercion and appears to be genuine.
5. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.72 dated 27.7.2017 under Sections 325, 323, 427, 452, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
