The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 13.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 2157 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“At the outset, learned State counsel submits that representation, Annexure P-7 submitted by the petitioner shall be looked into and appropriate decision taken thereon. The revenue record sought by the petitioner shall be furnished to the petitioner, if permissible under the law.

In view of above, petition is hereby disposed of. Needful shall be done within four months.”

Short reply dated 29.8.2019 by way of affidavit of Major Amit Sareen, PCS, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Hoshiarpur annexing order dated

9.8.2019 passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Hoshiarpur filed in Court is

taken on record. Copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed and the report prepared by Naib Tehsildar.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
