Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 07.08.2018, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

As per the FIR, police party headed by SI Bikramjit Singh and other police officials were going from village Dhandoli Kalan to village Rangla in the course of patrol duty along with laptop and printer in a private car. When the police party reached near village Dhandoli Kalan, at about 08:50 pm, a person was apprehended counting the tablets in the head light of the car, who on being asked disclosed his name as Amandeep Singh son of Sher Singh (the present petitioner) and 1750 tablets of Alprazolam were recovered from his possession.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bhagwan Singh has apprised the Court that only one prosecution witness remains to be examined and now the case is fixed for 19.04.2019.

In view of the above factual position, no ground for grant of

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bail pending trial to the petitioner is made out. Petition is, therefore, dismissed.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of case.
