Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in criminal complaint No.42 of 2015 titled Munshi Ram v. Nav Jyoti Breeding and Rearing Farms India Pvt. Ltd., under Sections 420, 463, 467, 468, 471, 406, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 05.12.2018 :-

“Contends that petitioner was merely a Computer Operator with the company namely Nav Jyoti Breeding and Rearing Farms India Pvt. Ltd. and he has no role in the commission of alleged offence.

Notice of motion for 18.01.2019.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within one week and he shall be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court. ”

It has been pointed out that in terms of the order dated

05.12.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the

learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul and granted regular bail vide order dated 07.12.2018. Copy of the order is retained on the file as Mark X.

In view of above, the interim order dated 05.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner will fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and will not seek unnecessary adjournments.
